



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

A Criminal's Profession

Discover Darlinghurst with this Trail Quest. This Trail Quest starts at Kings Cross Train Station. You will then explore St. Vincent's Hospital, The Courthouse and Stanley Street while walking past many historic buildings.

Darlinghurst has much history, and with both a Gaol and a Courthouse, it attracted many characters to the area. The Gaol built in 1836 housed many criminals over the years, including one of Sydney's most notorious criminals. Complete this Trail Quest to discover the profession of this criminal and a key date linked to them. Clues are scattered around the suburb. Solve this puzzle by following the directions and discovering the clues along the way.

Don't forget to submit the final answer to reveal the full story about this notorious criminal.

REMEMBER

Take care of your own and party safety especially when crossing the road.

Respect the environment and the surrounding buildings and take your litter home with you or place in a bin.

DID YOU KNOW?

The suburb became Darlinghurst in honour of Elizabeth Darling, the wife of Governor Ralph Darling. 'Hurst' was derived from an Old English word meaning wooded area.

DIRECTIONS:

You will NOT need a map to complete the Trail Quest. The directions will lead you from start to finish, even if you can not find a clue along the way.

Note: This part of Stanley Street is also known as Little Italy and has a number of good places to stop for refreshments.

DIRECTION 13

Continue along Stanley Street to Yurong Street Reserve.

CLUE N

Cross off a profession which you may have found here in 1867.

DIRECTION 14

Turn right along Yurong Street. Then right into William Street.

CLUE O

Deduct 50 years off the date the Strand Hotel was established. Cross off the year after the deduction.

DIRECTION 15

Continue along William Street to number 167.

CLUE P

Cross off Graeme Aitkens profession.

DIRECTION 16

Just past number 167, there is a set of stairs to your right.

**CLUE Q**

Cross off the date the Chard Stairs were constructed.

DIRECTION 17

Walk up the stairs, turn left along Premier Lane, and turn right into Rosebank Street. Then follow the road around to the right to the small park for the final two clues.

CLUE R

Cross off the year in which James Laidley died.

CLUE S

Cross off Donald Larnach's profession.



Congratulations! You have now finished this Trail Quest.

You should have one final profession and a final date.

Don't forget to text the answer. You will receive a free text back revealing the full story.

To return to Kings Cross Station, turn right out of the park along Farrell Avenue. At the end, turn left into Darlinghurst Road. Walk along the Road back to the station.

START POINT

This Trail Quest starts at Kings Cross Train Station. Turn right and then cross Darlinghurst Road at the pedestrian lights for the first clue.

CLUE A

Cross off a profession which could be attached to earlier names of Darlinghurst Road.

DIRECTION 1

Continue along Darlinghurst Road. You should be on the left side of the road. Cross Bayswater Road and Kings Cross Road for the next clue.

CLUE B

Cross off the date Stones against the sky was unveiled.

DIRECTION 2

Cross Craigend Street & turn left to walk along Craigend Street. Turn right into Nimrod Street.

CLUE C

Cross off a profession which you could find at The Stables.

DIRECTION 3

Turn left into Caldwell Street, then walk down Beares Stairs. Note: These stairs are heritage listed. Turn right into Surrey Street. At the end, cross Victoria Street at the pedestrian crossing to St Johns.

? CLUE D

Explore the grounds of the church. Cross off the date a plaque was set by The RT. REV.M.L.LOANE.

DIRECTION 4

Walk back to Victoria Street and turn right to walk along Victoria Street.

? CLUE E

Close by, cross off Anna Cohn's profession.

DIRECTION 5

Continue along Victoria Street, crossing both Liverpool and Burton street, to the park for the next two clues.

? CLUE F

Cross off Victor Chang's profession.

? CLUE G

Cross off Alexander Green's profession in 1828.

DIRECTION 6

Continue along Victoria Street. St Vincent's Hospital is on your left.

Note: St Vincent's Hospital was founded in 1857 by the Sisters of Charity and is one of Australia's most iconic Hospitals.

**DIRECTION 7**

Cross Victoria Street at the pedestrian crossing and walk along to the Private Hospital entrance.

? CLUE H

Cross off the year the Private hospital was founded by the Sisters of Charity.

DIRECTION 8

Walk through the Healing Garden to your right. Exit and re-join Victoria Street. At the traffic lights, turn right into Oxford Street.

Walk along to the Sacred Heart Church.

? CLUE I

Cross off James Nangle's profession.

DIRECTION 9

Continue along Oxford Street to the Courthouse.

? CLUE J

If M=1,000; DCCC=800; LXXX=80 cross off the date found on the Courthouse.

DIRECTION 10

Continue along Oxford Street past the Courthouse. Turn right into Taylor Square at the end of the Courthouse. Walk through the square & take the right fork along Forbes Street.

**? CLUE K**

Cross off the profession of the occupant of the Reception House on your left.

PHOTO OPPORTUNITY: Outside the Gaol on your right, take a picture and arrange yourselves in the shape of letters T and Q.

**DIRECTION 11**

Turn right into Burton Street, the old Gaol is on your right. Then turn left into Darlinghurst Road.

? CLUE L

Cross off the year Maccabean Hall was opened.

DIRECTION 12

There are no clues for a few streets.

Walk along Darlinghurst Road and turn left into Liverpool Street. Walk along and turn right into Bourke Street. Walk along then turn left into Stanley Street. Walk along Stanley Street for the next clue.

? CLUE M

Further along, cross off the date the Presbyterian Church was erected.
